- 1. when there's a series of three or more things a never put a comma after **and**
- 2. When the name of the sentence repeats put it between commas
- 3. After the number of the day in the date a. If the sentence continues after the year put a comma
- **4.** When a sentence starts with if put a comma after the first idea
- 5. After the introduction of a sentence
- 6. After yes, no, or sure
- 7. Between city and state in an address
 - a. If the address is written in on single line, put a coma between the name of the street and the city.
